Dear Praying Friends,

In March we hosted a pre-conference, a workshop and a luncheon at the largest church-planting gathering, at Exponential in Orlando. Each year over 6,000 pastors, church-planters, missional leaders gather to learn from each other and encourage each other in the difficult task of planting new multiplying churches around the world. Here are some of the feedbacks:

*“If you know anything about CRU, the first thing that comes to my mind is evangelism. I don’t know that there’s been a ministry that God has used more to bring more people to Jesus than CRU. When I found out that there was a residency, I wanted to be in. I wanted to see exactly what they were doing. And **what I love about them is they do equip you with very practical tools. It’s not up in the sky. And that is exactly what I needed.** And now, as a result of that, as part of our training of our church planters, we require that each church planter have a very practical plan for evangelism, not only for themselves, but for their core group and their members. They have to have a very practical plan. In our coaching now we are focusing on making sure they are executing that plan. **It’s not just on paper, but it’s in the dirt. It’s in the street. It’s out where people live.**”*
